Level: 2

Entry requirements:

- You need to be 16 years of age
- Work Ready
- Interested in a career in a warehousing environment

Typical duration: 12 - 14 months

Go further: On competition, you could progress onto level 3 qualifications in Management and Logistics Operations which can lead onto more senior positions.



Course overview:

This Apprenticeship is ideal for individuals working/seeking a role in the distribution sector. The qualification will help develop well trained individuals to undertake varied warehousing, storage and logistics activities.

The components in this Apprenticeship are:

- **Level 2 Certificate in Warehousing and Storage**
- **Functional Skills in Maths and English**
- **Employment rights and responsibilities**
- **Personal learning and thinking skills**

You will study a number of mandatory units as well as choosing optional units to match your job role.

Mandatory units:

- Health, safety and security at work
- Develop effective working relationships with colleagues in logistic operations

Optional units:

There are a number of units to choose from, here is an example of some of the units you can choose to study:

- Pick goods in a logistics operations
- Process orders from customers
- Keep stock at required levels in logistic operations
- Receive goods in logistic environments
- Supervise the receipt, storage and dispatch of goods

English and Maths:

A good standard of English and maths is essential when working in any environment which is why they are included in all apprenticeships.

We will assess your current level of English and maths to identify any support you may need, and depending on your current qualifications, we will agree on the level of English and maths you will need to complete.

This may include taking English and maths qualifications at Level 1 or Level 2, but if your current qualifications mean you don't need to complete further maths or English, we will still help you to develop these skills during your apprenticeship. If you don't have any current qualifications, don't worry, we will support you to achieve these essential skills.

Duration:

The programme is delivered during normal working hours, making it a real opportunity to learn while you earn. Timescales for completion depend on the individual, but the qualification takes a minimum of 12 months.

Assessment:

To achieve a pass for the full qualification, you must achieve all the units in the stated qualification structure. You will do this by producing a portfolio of evidence. You will also take part in Functional Skills Tests for Maths and English.

About the sector:

Warehousing and the storage of goods is an essential part of logistics operations within a business. Roles within logistics require great skill and organisation to coordinate the demand and supply of goods and ultimately meet customer needs.

This may include operating specialist machinery, loading objects of different shapes and sizes, keeping some goods at low temperatures, managing stock, auditing inventory, keeping equipment in good working order, processing returned goods and managing the receipt, storage and dispatch of goods.
